



CABINET OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS – POST MEETING SUMMARY

A meeting of the Cabinet was convened on Wednesday, 1st April 2026 in the Cabinet Conference Room, Government Administration Building.

All Ministers and Members of Cabinet were present.

At this meeting Cabinet:

- a) Confirmed the approval by circulation on 27th March 2026, for the Customs and Border Control (Visas, Entry and Landing) (Amendment) Regulations, 2026;
- b) Confirmed the approval by circulation on 30th March 2026, for the Proceeds of Crime (Amendment) Bill, 2026 for submission to Parliament;
- c) Approved the issuance of drafting instructions to the Legislative Drafting Department to amend the Anti-Money Laundering Regulations (2025 Revision) to address deficiencies identified pursuant to section 145 of the Proceeds of Crime Act (2025 Revision);
- d) Approved pursuant to section 7 of the National Roads Authority Act (2024 Revision) the following appointments and re-appointments of individuals to serve on the Board of Directors of the National Roads Authority: Anthony Travers, Chairperson; Geoffrey Ebanks, Director; Arleth Gould, Director; Peter Campbell, Director and Dominic Williams, Director;
- e) Approved in principle the development of legislation to establish a comprehensive statutory vetting framework for the Cayman Islands Government, applicable to the Cayman Islands Government, including the Civil Service and Statutory Authorities and Government Companies;
- f) Approved the transfer of capital funding from the Ministry of Planning, Lands, Agriculture, Housing, and Infrastructure to the Ministry of District Administration and Home Affairs, which will be reported to Parliament in accordance with sections 11(5) and 11(6) of the Public Management and Finance Act (2026 Revision);
- g) Approved the Public Transport (Amendment and Validation) Bill, 2026 for submission to Parliament;
- h) Approved the reallocation of funds within the Ministry of Planning, Lands, Agriculture, Housing, and Infrastructure, which will be reported to Parliament in accordance with sections 11(5) and 11(6) of the Public Management and Finance Act (2026 Revision);
- i) Approved pursuant to section 3(1) of the Adoption of Children Act (2021 Revision), the reappointment of Sheridan Brooks-Hurst as Chairperson of the Adoption Board; and
- j) Noted the Hamilton Declaration II on Collaboration for the Conservation of the Sargasso Sea.
