



CABINET OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS – POST MEETING SUMMARY

A meeting of the Cabinet was convened on Wednesday, 22nd April 2026 in the Cabinet Conference Room, Government Administration Building.

The Hon Nickolas DaCosta acted for the Hon Minister for Planning, Lands, Agriculture, Housing and Infrastructure. All other Ministers and Members of Cabinet were present.

At this meeting Cabinet:

- a) Confirmed approval granted by circulation on 17th April 2026 for the grant of a Cabinet permit for temporarily entry to the Cayman Islands;
- b) Approved pursuant to section 21 of the National Conservation Act 2013 the issuance of a Coastal Works Permit for the construction of a dock;
- c) Reviewed and noted the Ministry of Finance and Economic Development's Financial Statements and Annual Report for the period ending 31st December 2025 and approved its onward submission to Parliament;
- d) Reviewed and noted the Ministry of Education and Training's Financial Statements and Annual Report for the period ending 31st December 2025 and approved its onward submission to Parliament;
- e) Accepted recommendations from the Little Cayman Airport Redevelopment Working Group and approved milestones, timelines and authorised the relevant Ministries to seek supplementary funding;
- f) Approved the issuance of drafting instructions to amend the Customs Tariff Act (2026 Revision) and the Border Control (Prohibited Goods) Order (2025 Revision);
- g) Approved the establishment of a multi-agency working group to review and make recommendations for legislative reform relating to sexual offences and online safety and the issuance of drafting instructions to amend the Penal Code (2026 Revision) and the development of a new Bill;
- h) Noted the Cayman Islands Resilience Index Project update; and
- i) Noted the Financial Report for the period 1st January 2026 – 28th February 2026.
