



CABINET OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS – POST MEETING SUMMARY

A meeting of the Cabinet was convened on Wednesday, 29th April 2026 in the Cabinet Conference Room, Government Administration Building.

The Hon Nickolas DaCosta acted for the Hon Minister for Finance and Economic Development. All other Ministers and Members of Cabinet were present.

At this meeting Cabinet:

- a) Reviewed and noted the Hazard Management Cayman Islands' Annual Report 2025 and authorised Hon Premier to table in Parliament;
- b) Authorised pursuant to section 4(1) of the Roads Act (2005 Revision) for the National Roads Authority to enter land for the limited purpose of undertaking survey investigation and data collection to support planning and design of the proposed corridor of the Linford Pierson Highway as depicted in Boundary Plan No 707;
- c) Authorised pursuant to section 4(1) of the Roads Act (2005 Revision) for the National Roads Authority to enter land for the limited purpose of undertaking survey investigation and data collection to support planning and design of the proposed road of the East-West Arterial Extension as depicted in Boundary Plan No 697;
- d) Reviewed and noted the Ministry of Social Development and Innovation's Annual Report and Audited Financial Statements for the period ending 31st December 2024 and authorised the Hon Minister to table in Parliament;
- e) Noted Private Member's Motion No 4, No 5, No 6 and No 10 of 2025-2026 and authorised the Hon Premier to provide reports on these positions to Parliament at next meeting;
- f) Approved pursuant to Regulation 4 of the Air Transport (Licensing of Air Services) Regulations, 1997 and section 9 of the Public Authorities Act (2020 Revision) the re-appointment and appointment of the following persons to the Air Transport Licensing Authority: Michael Adam, Chairperson; Marcus Cumber, Deputy Chairperson; Gary Bodden, Member; Peter Schmid, Member; Paula Cribb, Member; Susan Parsons, Member; Carson (Denny) Ebanks, Member; and Elaine Whorms, Secretary;
- g) Approved the issuance of drafting instructions to amend Schedule 3 of the Monetary Authority Act (2020 Revision);
- h) Approved the issuance of updated drafting instructions to amend the Local Companies (Control) Act (2025 Revision);
- i) Approved supplementary funding for the Ministry of Health, Environment and Sustainability (Mosquito Research and Control Unit), which will be reported to Parliament pursuant to sections 11(5) and 11(6) of the Public Management and Finance Act (2026 Revision);
- j) Approved another supplementary funding for the Ministry of Health, Environment and Sustainability, which will be reported to Parliament pursuant to sections 11(5) and 11(6) of the Public Management and Finance Act (2026 Revision);

- k) Approved a temporary entry permit pursuant to section 90 of the Customs and Border Control Act (2024 Revision);
- l) Approved the Terms of Reference for the Cayman Islands Public and Affordable Housing Policy and 10-year Strategic Plan Implementation Steering Committee;
- m) Refused 2 requests for exemptions from section 53(1)(b) of the Immigration (Transition) Act (2022 Revision);
- n) Approved 1 exemption from section 53(1)(b) of the Immigration (Transition) Act (2022 Revision);
- o) Reviewed and noted the Twenty-first Annual Report of the Law Reform Commission and authorised the Hon Attorney General to present to Parliament;
- p) Noted the Cayman Islands' Third Quarter Economic Report 2025; and
- q) Noted the Cayman Islands' Labour Force Survey Report: Fall 2025.
