



CABINET OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS – POST MEETING SUMMARY

A meeting of the Cabinet was convened on Wednesday, 10th June 2026 in the Cabinet Conference Room, Government Administration Building.

The Hon Gary Rutty acted as Premier, the Hon Johany Ebanks acted as Deputy Premier, the Hon Michael Myles acted as Minister for Financial Services and Commerce, Parliamentary Secretary, Mrs. Heather Bodden acted as Temporary Minister for Health, Environment and Sustainability and Chief Officer, Mr. Wesley Howell acted as Deputy Governor.
