

Birth Certificate Fees	A fee reduction of 50% is in effect for the issuance of birth certificates for persons aged sixty-five and older. The new fee is \$5 – which is a reduction on the previous \$10 fee. Cabinet approved the discount, which also applies to applicants requesting the certificate on behalf of older persons.
