Criteria for Older Persons Month Ambassador

1. The title of **Ambassador** is annually given to an individual of good character, age 65 years and older, for making a substantial impact at a community, district, or national level in the Cayman Islands.
2. The **Ambassador** designation recognises an individual's leadership in the promotion of and participation in charitable causes and organizations in support of older persons.
3. The **Ambassador** will be someone who advocates to enhance the lives of other older persons.
4. This designation recognises the contributions of persons, in their older years, who also contribute to their community by serving all generations.
5. The nominee should have participated in a broad scope of activities over the course of more than three years. This is not a designation for a single event, no matter how well it was executed.
6. Recognition will be given for leadership and performance for work above and beyond his/her paid profession.
7. The **Ambassador** designation will not be given posthumously.
