



CABINET OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS – POST MEETING SUMMARY

A meeting of the Cabinet was convened on Wednesday, 11th in the Cabinet Conference Room, Government Administration Building.

Hon Franz Manderson acted as Governor; Hon Gary Ruddy acted as Premier; Hon Rolston Anglin acted as Deputy Premier; Parliamentary Secretary Hon G. Wayne Panton acted as Temporary Minister for Financial Service and Commerce; Hon Nickolas DaCosta acted for Hon Minister Johany Ebanks, Minister of Planning, Lands, Agriculture and Housing; Mr. Stran Bodden acted as Deputy Governor and Mrs Marilyn Brandt acted as Attorney General. All other Ministers and Members of Cabinet were present.

At this meeting Cabinet:

- a) Confirmed approval granted by circulation on 9th February 2026 for the issuance of drafting instructions to amend the Health Insurance Act (2021 Revision); Health Insurance Commission (Amendment) Bill, 2026 and the Health Insurance (Amendment) Regulations, 2026;
- b) Approved pursuant to section 52 of the Customs and Border Control Act (2024 Revision), two refunds of import duty;
- c) Approved the issuance of drafting instructions to amend the Adoption Act, 2024;
- d) Approved pursuant to Regulation 16(b) of the Legal Practitioners (Students) Regulations (2018 Revision) to permit a person to register for Articles of Clerkship;
- e) Approved pursuant to section 3 of the Notaries Public Act (2023 Revision) the appointment of the following persons as Notaries Public: Hayley Allister, Satania Cowan, Abigail Guilmette, Jaron Leslie, Kayleigh Mascarenhas, and Alice Narborough;
- f) Approved the opening of a public road and the publication of Declarations pursuant to sections 3 and 6 of the Roads Act (2005 Revision) as depicted by Boundary Plan No. 700;
- g) Approved the lease of office space for the Department of Labour and Pensions in Cayman Brac;
- h) Approved the renewal of lease for the Department of Community Rehabilitation in Cayman Brac;
- i) Noted the Tax Undertaking Statistics for December 2025 and January 2026;
- j) Noted the Cayman Islands Aquatic Centre update; and
- k) Noted the 2025 Civil Service Employee Engagement Survey highlights.
