WHEREAS section 83(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands provides that the sessions of the Parliament of the Cayman Islands shall be held at such places and begin at such times as the Governor may from time to time by proclamation appoint:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jane Owen, Governor of the Cayman Islands, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by section 83(1) of the Constitution of the Cayman Islands HEREBY PROCLAIM that a session of the Parliament of the Cayman Islands shall begin and be held at the Parliament Building, George Town, Grand Cayman at 2 p.m. on the 6th day of May, 2025 and shall thereafter continue until such date and time as the Parliament may adjourn thereto.
