Every driver has the power to make Cayman's roads safer.

Driving under the influence doesn't just risk your licence - it risks lives.

The Risk

Since 2022, more than **800** people in Cayman have been arrested and prosecuted for driving under the influence.

Alcohol and drugs slow your reflexes, blur your vision, and cloud your judgement. Even before you reach the legal limit of 0.07%, your coordination slips — and so does your ability to make safe decisions.

Impaired drivers are more likely to drift across lanes, miss stop signs, or fail to see someone crossing the road. Those split seconds can cause a crash that changes lives forever.

Smart Drivers



Plan ahead - decide who's driving before you go out. Offer to be the designated driver for family, friends, or coworkers. Use the CI:GO app or visit caymantransport.ky for local taxi options.



Know your limits - fatigue and medication can impair you too.



Never risk it - Choose a designated driver before you head out. Hand over the keys to someone you trust and never take the risk of driving impaired.
